Weekly Attendance Figures

<u>Reception – 91.67%</u>

<u>Class 1 – 97.84%</u>

Well done to Class 1 who achieved the highest attendance this week! The expectation is that schools maintain an attendance level of <u>at least 97%</u>. This is the measure that schools are subject to during both local and national inspections. Figures below that level will be heavily criticized. We appreciate your support with this. It is also a legal requirement for children to attend school regularly. Please ensure that children are in school and on time every day and please avoid term time holidays. We are aware that there are lots of illnesses going around at the moment, please refer to the NHS guidance <u>here</u> when determining whether or not to keep your child off school.

DID YOU KNOW?

Whilst 95% attendance doesn't sound too bad, across a year it means your child would have missed 9 days of school, or 45 lessons. Over 7 years of primary school, 95% attendance each year would add up to 12.5 weeks or 3 months or one whole term of missed school.
