Free School Meals

Many families qualify for benefits-related Free School Meals without realising. We would encourage families to apply, even if they have been unsuccessful in the past. You can apply for Free School Meals on the North Yorkshire Council website here. If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and currently receives free school meals as part of the Universal Infant Free School Meal programme, we would still encourage you to apply for benefits-related Free School Meals. This enables us to ensure that appropriate funding is received by school.

SEND Survey for Parents

North Yorkshire Council is aiming to get a broad consensus on the essential elements and format for a SEND Inclusive Practice Framework and would like parents to complete a short survey. The Framework will aim to guide teachers and school staff in reviewing inclusive practice in schools, to ensure schools can create learning environments that are inclusive to all children and to give a common set of expectations about what a school could be doing to meet the needs of children aged 5-16 with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities. All nine questions in the survey are optional, and all responses are anonymous. Please do not include any details that could identify you, your children, the school or anyone else. Well done to Class 3 who achieved the highest attendance this week! The expectation is that schools maintain an attendance level of at least 97%. DID YOU KNOW?

Whilst 95% attendance doesn't sound too bad, across a year it means your child would have missed 9 days of school, or 45 lessons. Over 7 years of primary school, 95% attendance each year would add up to 12.5 weeks or 3 months or one whole term of missed school.
